

Message From Our Pastor



My beloved parishioners of St. Michael's Church,



On behalf of our parish, I would like to congratulate Deacon Michael Alfano, a member of our parish family, who was ordained to the Permanent Deaconate for service of the Church of Newark Archdiocese. Deacon Michael was among the 10 Deacons—Class of 2020—ordained on Saturday, July 11th, 2020, by His Eminence, Cardinal Joseph Tobin; the Archbishop of

Newark, with Monsignor Anselm Nwaorgu and Deacon Michael Cavallo, in attendance. Deacon Michael Alfano has been assigned to his home parish, St. Michael Church, Union for his Pastoral work—the Church where he made his First Communion and Confirmation.

Deacon Michael has a Bachelor's degree in Physical and Life Sciences from Notre Dame University, where he developed a deep sense of the need to be involved and to be committed to Catholic ministry and community service. Over time, this led to his desire to become a Permanent Deacon, and five years ago, he committed, and registered, and began the long and tedious program in preparation for the Permanent Deaconate. He went through the five-year theological Studies established by the Archdiocese of Newark in conjunction with Seton Hall University that led to his graduating with a master's degree in systematic theology.

We are so glad and fortunate to have Deacon Michael added to our Parish Staff because he is already one of our own. He has, for several years, served St. Michael's Parish as, the coordinator and teacher of the Right of Christian Initiation for Adults program, a Eucharistic Minister, and a Lector. We now have an extra hand to help out with Sunday homilies, Baptisms, weddings, wakes, and Non-Eucharistic funeral Services.

I request that all the members of our Church family keep Deacon Michael in their prayers, as he begins his new ministry, as a Deacon, here at St. Michael's Parish.

Deacon Michael, we congratulate you and wish you every grace necessary for the fruitful fulfillment of your vocation as a Permanent Deacon in the Catholic Church. Our prayers are with you. Welcome on board, my dear friend.

FIRST RECONCILATION:

Dates for your child's First Reconciliation have been scheduled. There will be two services and they will begin at 10:00 am in the Church.

Children whose last names begin with A-L will attend on SATURDAY, JULY 18TH.

Children whose last names begin with M-Z will attend on SATURDAY, AUGUST 1ST.

Due to Church guidelines and restrictions, we are only allowed 100 people in the Church at this time. **This** means only one parent and one child can attend the reconciliation service.

Your child can receive this sacrament <u>ONLY IF</u> we have received proof of their Baptism. If you have received a letter asking for proof and have yet to provide it, please do so immediately. Letters were only sent to those who have not provided proof.

If you need to change the date of the reconciliation, please call the office as soon as possible. Please call or email the office once you have received the letter packet.

PARENTS OF CHILDREN IN OUR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM:

REGISTRATION PAPERS FOR THE 2020-2021 CCD YEAR have been mailed. Please register your child for religious education classes. If you know of someone who has a child entering the first grade, please ask them to contact the Religious Education Office. We will send registration papers to them. Special classes are available for older students who haven't had any prior religious instruction.

PARENTS OF SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN: Religious education begins in first grade and continues through grade eight. Children usually receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Eucharist (Communion) in the second grade. Most children are confirmed in the ninth grade, as long as they have completed grades one through eight. If you have a child who needs to make up classes, please contact the Religious Education Office.
