

Message From *The Pastors Desk*

WHEN PATIENCE WITH THE LORD GETS A WORKOUT



The first stanza of this Sunday's Responsorial Psalm, (2nd Sunday in year A), is taken from Psalm 40:1-2: "I waited patiently for the Lord; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. He brought me up out of the pit of destruction...and set my feet upon a rock... He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God." Apparently, David was facing a terrible situation—in a deep pit of destruction and a cesspool of miry clay. He prayed for deliverance and patiently waited for the Lord to respond. His patience paid off and the Lord did respond.

A few days back, one of our young adults asked me, "Monsignor, the Bible says that whatever you ask of God and believing that it is done, will be given to you. Do you believe that because it doesn't seem to be true?" The real test of our faith truly comes when our patience gets a real workout; when prayer meets the silence of being kept on hold, and God's answer seems to be "no answer" and we conclude "I guess it is not meant to be". The question then becomes whether we have enough faith to trust and assume a holding pattern and wait for the fulfillment of the promise.

Life will present us with adversities and tribulations; seasons of struggle, conflict, and brokenness. In these moments, it is important to remember the words of Scripture, "But God remembered Noah and all the beasts and all the cattle that were with him in the ark; and God caused a wind to pass over the earth, and the water subsided." My friends, the Lord knows where you are, where you have been,

and how much you have left in your reserve. He is capable of sending the wind to blow back the waters of adversity just to provide for what you need. God does not forget as Scripture says, "For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name" (Hebrew 6:10). God's word tells us to patiently wait for the fulfillment of His promises (Cf. Habakkuk 2:3).

It is important to remember these words of scripture when we are in a holding pattern. I once asked an elderly lady to tell me her favorite verse in the Bible and she answered, "It is, 'this too shall pass.'" Life is full of seasons of sunshine as well as seasons of rain and snow and yet for each stage, there is a purpose and an expiration date. There is nothing we can do to rush God's plan. It is never "by human might or power, but by the Spirit of the Lord" (Zechariah 4:6).

We know from the Bible that the devil does everything possible to delay the fulfillment of God's promises in our lives (Cf. Daniel 10). It is comforting to know, though, that no demonic power can stop what God had ordained for your life. God's answers and blessings may not always come the way we think it to come. It may be delayed, but it is never denied. When we are going through stuff, let us remember that God is always capable of taking care of business even of things we think to be impossible.

May the good Lord put a new song in our mouth; a song of praise to our God and at the time we need it most. Amen!

ST. MICHAEL'S COLLECTIONS

Below is an explanation of some of the different St. Michael's Collections:

S.O.S. Collection - This is a monthly "restricted" collection dedicated to paying our utility bills. *Restricted collections are not assessed by the Archdiocese of Newark and therefore all funds are used solely by St. Michael's to pay our bills.* S.O.S. collections are appreciated at all times.

Tithing - This is a monthly "restricted" collection dedicated to paying for the new air conditioner. *Restricted collections are not assessed by the Archdiocese and therefore all funds are used solely for St. Michael's needs.* Tithing collections are appreciated at all times.

Assessment Collection - The Archdiocese of Newark assesses all parishes in the Archdiocese, and a percentage of the parish's annual unrestricted revenue, is paid monthly. This assessment is used by the Archdiocese to

support administrative services. St. Michael's has instituted a monthly "restricted" collection that is used solely for paying our monthly assessment. **All Assessment Collection funds are sent directly to Archdiocese of Newark, monthly, to pay our Assessment Obligation. No funds are used for St. Michael's needs.**

National Collections - the Archdiocese of Newark has ten collections during the year to benefit various organizations such as the retired priest's fund, the church in Eastern Europe, the religious retirement fund, and mission appeals. **Money from the national collections go directly to the Archdiocese of Newark.**

St. Vincent De Paul Collection - money donated to St. Vincent De Paul is distributed prior to Thanksgiving and prior to Easter to local foodbanks, soup kitchens and social centers that provide food and shelter for those in need.





**TO ALL OUR PARISHIONERS:
PREVENTING SCAMS IN OUR PARISH**

There is increasing use of many Pastor's names, via email or text message, to try to scam parishioners. They have tried it severally with many pastors in our diocese. Please do not be scammed. You can prevent this by taking a few things in consideration.

- A. If you receive a text message or email and you don't know your pastor's phone number or email, do not reply to the message sent in his name unless it comes from the Parish Office. **You need to call the Parish and verify the message.**
- B. If someone texts, emails or calls you in a way that implies urgency, attempting to get you to act quickly before you have time to carefully read and examine the message. Be careful how you respond. Verify first.
- C. If you receive any text, email, or call pressuring you to send funds via gift cards for whatever reason, by asking you for the code numbers or PINs on the back of the cards so that the card can be redeemed immediately, be careful how you respond. Verify first.
- D. If you receive any text or email, or call telling you a story about the urgent need of your pastor or someone you don't relate with at that level, that involves a medical emergency, being stranded somewhere, or for travel needs, be careful how you respond. Make sure the phone number or email address is verified.

We just need to be smart and we can beat these attempts at scamming parishioners. It is nearly impossible to locate where the scam is originating from or the number being used. What we can do is to be watchful. Always look at the number and email from which the message is being sent. If it is not a number or email address you are familiar with, your best bet is not to respond or verify before you respond.


